The West Louisville Performing Arts Academy boasts a rich 30-year history of empowering youth through music education, choral performance, community service, and diverse experiences. Launched by Mr. McDaniel Bluitt in 1990, the boys' Choir was inspired by the Harlem Boys Choir's success and structure. In the three decades since its inception, the West Louisville Boys Choir traveled and performed across the United States.

A high watermark of the Choir's journey was its tour of Europe, where

they sang on the steps of Buckingham Palace in Great Britain and performed a pop-up concert in front of the Louvre Museum in Paris, France. The Choir achieved these successes with the support and participation of gracious friends and donors.

Mr. McDaniel and Mrs. Mamie Bluitt have grown the original Boys Choir into what is now known as the West Louisville Performing Arts Academy. The Academy now includes the West Louisville Girls' Choir and the guitar ensemble.

A Plan For Future Sustainability

50 Million Penny Sustained Giving Campaign
